The fumes were noxious, but non-threatening.
- 2. All prisoners scheduled to appear on Tuesday, June 8, 2010, will be brought before the Court on Wednesday, June 9, 2010. Individuals out on bond are scheduled to reappear before the Court on Thursday, July 15, 2010. All overnight defendants were sent to Central Bond Court.
