ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2020-7: (Extension of Administrative Order 2020-06 through and including July 2, 2020 or until further order of Court)

RE: COVID-19 – EMERGENCY MEASURES EXTENDED from June 1, 2020 through and including July 2, 2020 or until further order of Court.

IN CONJUNCTION WITH CHIEF JUDGE TIMOTHY EVANS' GENERAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER: 2020-01 and amendments thereto, Presiding Judge Shelley Sutker-Dermer, of the Second Municipal District, issues this Administrative Order extending Emergency Measures at the Second Municipal District from June 1, 2020 through and including July 2, 2020 or until further order of Court. Administrative Order 2020-06 remains in effect with the following modifications.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. TRAFFIC and MISDEMEANOR:

All matters from June 1, 2020 through and including July 2, 2020 are continued. No one is to appear in court until further notice from the Clerk's Office.

All prosecutors and defense attorneys should review their caseloads to prioritize and plan for rescheduling.

Emergency misdemeanor motions and traffic misdemeanor motions will be heard in Courtroom 105.

2. CRIMINAL:

A. FELONY:

All set felony matters from June 1, 2020 through and including July 2, 2020 will be rescheduled. No defendant should appear in court. Defense attorneys/*pro se* defendants should contact the State's Attorney's first chair to coordinate a future date for rescheduling. Should no continuance date be submitted to the Court, the default dates shall be set by order of Court as follows:

Cases set for June 1, 2020 will have a default date of July 20, 2020

Cases set for June 2, 2020 will have a default date of July 21, 2020

Cases set for June 3, 2020 will have a default date of July 22, 2020

Cases set for June 4, 2020 will have a default date of July 23, 2020

Cases set for June 5, 2020 will have a default date of July 24, 2020

Cases set for June 8, 2020 will have a default date of July 27, 2020

Cases set for June 9, 2020 will have a default date of July 28, 2020

Cases set for June 10, 2020 will have a default date of July 29, 2020

Cases set for June 11, 2020 will have a default date of July 30, 2020
Cases set for June 12, 2020 will have a default date of July 31, 2020
Cases set for June 15, 2020 will have a default date of August 3, 2020
Cases set for June 16, 2020 will have a default date of August 4, 2020
Cases set for June 17, 2020 will have a default date of August 5, 2020
Cases set for June 18, 2020 will have a default date of August 6, 2020
Cases set for June 19, 2020 will have a default date of August 7, 2020
Cases set for June 22, 2020 will have a default date of August 10, 2020

Cases set for July 2, 2020 will have a default date of August 20, 2020

Courtrooms 107, 108 and 206 will conduct felony emergency matters and felony set matters to review on a case-by-case basis for prioritizing and rescheduling in Courtroom 108 at 10 a.m. via videoconferencing. Zoom ID: 151-027-649.

Courtrooms 207, 208 and 209 will conduct felony emergency matters and felony set matters to review on a case-by-case basis for prioritizing and rescheduling in Courtroom 208 at 9 a.m. via videoconferencing. Zoom ID: 964-4905-8153.

All Three Preliminary Hearing Calls and Bond Hearings will be conducted in Courtroom 105.

No warrants will be issued for failure to appear in court from the effective date of this Order through and including July 2, 2020.

B. PROBLEM SOLVING COURTS:

Problem solving courts will be proceeding via videoconferencing. Defendant need not appear and will be notified of future dates.

3. DOMESTIC VIOLENCE:

Petitions for Emergency Orders of Protection, Emergency Civil No Contact Orders, Emergency Stalking No Contact Orders will be conducted in Courtroom 105. All matters will proceed in accordance with the Administrative Orders issued by Presiding Judge Raul Vega of the Domestic Violence Division.

4. DOMESTIC RELATIONS:

Emergency matters will be heard remotely by the judge assigned in the district. All matters will proceed in accordance with the Administrative Orders issued by Presiding Judge Grace Dickler of the Domestic Relations Division.

5. CIVIL:

A. Law Division:

Cases before Judge Jeffrey Warnick in Courtroom 202 are being heard as assigned via Zoom videoconferencing – Meeting ID 925-0801-8507. Law Division matters in the Second Municipal District will proceed in accordance with the Second Municipal District and Law Division Protocol, effective June 1, 2020.

B. Municipal Division Calls in 202 and 204:

(1) Municipal cases in 202 and 204 (other than the *Pro Se* and Forcible Entry and Detainer which are discussed below) will proceed in accordance with the Second Municipal District and Law Division Protocol, effective June 1, 2020.

(2) *Pro Se* Calls in Courtroom 204 are stricken off call. Parties will receive notice from the Clerk's Office of the new date. Any cases that have agreed orders between the parties, such as dismissal orders, payment plans or orders to continue for 60 days to another Monday may be filed electronically and e-mailed to: ccc.skokiecivil204@cookcountyil.gov for approval and entry. All matters will proceed in accordance with the Second Municipal District and Law Division Protocol, effective June 1, 2020.

(3) Forcible Entry and Detainer Call, Courtroom 204, Fridays:

All matters will proceed in accordance with the Second Municipal District and Law Division Protocol, effective June 1, 2020.

6. MANDATORY ARBITRATION:

All arbitrations scheduled between June 1, 2020 through and including July 2, 2020 are cancelled. Parties will be notified by the Court as to future dates.

7. EXPUNGEMENTS:

All expungement hearings will proceed in Courtroom 108 via videoconferencing at the previously scheduled date and time. Zoom ID: 151-027-649. No defendants are to appear in court. Parties will be notified by the Court of any continuances or new dates.

8. JUVENILE JUSTICE DIVISION:

Juvenile detention hearings and demands for trial will be conducted daily at 1100 S. Hamilton, Ave., Chicago.

9. MARRIAGES and CIVIL UNIONS:

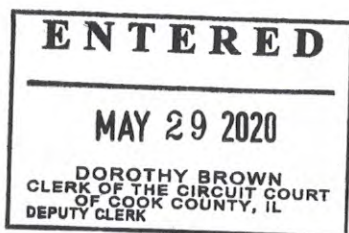
