Expert witness discovery completed no later than	17
All discovery completed and all final dispositive motions filed no later than	20
Set for trial no later than	24

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

The Court retains the authority to modify this order for good cause on its own motion or by a motion of a party where appropriate. Failure of any party to comply with this order may be a basis for Illinois Supreme Court Rule 219(c) sanctions. Failure of any party to enforce this order may constitute a waiver of such discovery by that party.
