**GENERAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER No. 2024 – 01**

**SUBJECT: *Adult Probation Department Drug Overdose Response Program***

Pursuant to the Anti-Opioid Program and Administration Standards (eff. Jan. 2016, amend. Oct. 2022) (Standards) of the Administrative Office of the Illinois Courts (AOIC) and the Probation and Probation Officers Act, 730 ILCS 110/15(1),

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that, effective January 8, 2024, the Circuit Court of Cook County Adult Probation Department is authorized to develop and administer a drug overdose response program that includes procedures for the administration of opioid antagonists; and

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that said program shall fully comply with the AOIC Standards and include written policies and procedures for the acquisition, storage, and use or administration of opioid antagonists by probation officers who are trained as overdose responders, including provisions for record keeping and reporting to the Illinois Department of Public Health, Division of Substance Use Prevention and Recovery, and the AOIC Probation Services Division.
