GENERAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER No. 2024-03

SUBJECT: Rescheduled cases, power outage, Fifth Municipal District

The courthouse in and for the Fifth Municipal District having experienced a weather related loss of electrical power throughout the building, and the schedule for restoration of the power being unknown at this time,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, effective immediately, to further public safety and the efficient administration of justice, cases scheduled to be heard January 12, 2024, in the Fifth Municipal District shall be heard as follows:

- 1. All criminal cases scheduled for initial appearance shall be heard at the Leighton Criminal Courthouse in Chicago;
- 2. All other felony cases shall be continued to Friday, January 19, 2024;
- 3. All traffic and misdemeanor cases shall be continued to a date to be determined by the Presiding Judge; the circuit clerk shall notify all parties of the new court date;
- 4. Initial appearances in domestic violence cases shall be heard at the Leighton Criminal Courthouse in Chicago; new petitions for emergency civil protective orders shall be heard at the Domestic Violence Courthouse, 555 W. Harrison St., Chicago; assistance with emergency protective order hearings or information about a criminal order of protection shall be available at:
 - a. Connections for Abused Women and their Children: (773) 278-4566 (24-hour hotline);
 - b. Illinois Domestic Violence Hotline in Chicago: (877) 863-6338. The hotline is toll free and confidential;
- 5. All other domestic violence cases shall be continued to Wednesday, January 17, 2024; and
- 6. Unless already continued, all other civil cases shall be continued to Tuesday, January 16, 2024.
