If you need assistance with e-filing, you can contact the Circuit Clerk's office by calling **(312) 603-6300** or emailing **DRCourtDate@cookcountycourt.com.**

You may be exempted from e-filing if you have a disability, are filing in a domestic violence case, cannot read or write in English, or cannot easily access a computer with internet.
