Section 1.3 IS AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

1.3 Jury Cases Set For Trial:

Effective on or after May 3, 2021 Jury Trials will resume and shall be scheduled at the discretion of the Presiding Judge of the Law Division, assuming resources and public health guidelines permit the scheduling.

The court will begin the Jury Trial setting process with cases originally set for trial on March 17, 2020 and continue in order with cases set for Jury Trial on March 18, 2020, then cases set for Jury Trial March 19, 2020, then cases set for Jury Trial on March 20, 2020, then cases set for Jury Trial on March 23, 2020, and so on.

Please note that COVID space restrictions may impact the jury cases initially set for trial.

Parties shall receive a minimum of 30 days notice prior to a Jury Trial commencing.

This order shall take effect immediately upon signing. Nothing in this order shall limit the Presiding Judges discretion to set trials on dates he chooses.
